For installation in 345-DVTE31LN-1 and 345-DVTE31LP-1 (see the Installation, Operation, and Maintenance Manual included with the fireplace)

Overview

The Archgard pan burner bed and fiber logs are designed to give a realistic fire package, and created to look the same as the day they were originally installed even after many years of use. Care must be given when first installing the logs, and if removed for servicing, as they can be damaged or broken if not handled properly.

After opening the log set package, inspect the logs to ensure that no damage has occurred inside the package. Please report any damage immediately to your Authorized Archgard Dealer.

Gas and vent connection must be made before installing the embers and logs on the pan burner.

CAUTION: DO NOT block pilot opening with embers or glass media material.

NOTE: Improper placement of logs and embers may cause soot accumulation on the internal parts and glass. This is not covered under warranty. Do not use broken or damaged logs.

Many of the logs use the locator pins located on the burner to position the logs. There are holes in the bottom of the log to help align them to the unique position on the burner.

IMPORTANT: Embers should be placed so as not to completely block burner ports.

After the initial firing, it may be necessary to shift logs slightly or adjust embers if the logs have excessive sooting or to improve the distribution of the flames. To increase the height of flames, add embers or adjust embers closer to secondary air openings adjacent to the flame. To reduce the height of flames, remove a few embers or adjust the embers away from secondary openings adjacent to the flame.

Ensure the fireplace is off and cool before adjusting burner media.

Locator Pins

NOTE: Installing the fiber logs in any other position other than shown will result in flame impingement causing sooting of the logs, brick liner and ceramic glass viewing area.



Grand Timber & Silver Birch Log Sets

There are slight differences between the Grand Timber and SIIver Birch Log Sets and the Weathered Wood Log Set.

The following instructions show the installation of the Grand Timber Log Set, however the installation of Silver Birch is identical. Installation of the Weathered Wood Log Set may be found on **Page 10**.




Figure 02: Grand Timber Log Set Identification




Figure 03: Silver Birch Log Set Identification



Step 1: Place Log 01 on the pin the left, rear corner of the firebox.

Step 2: Place Log 02 on other two pins in the back of the firebox.





Step 3: Install the log bracket in the holes on the left side of the burner using the two (2) black tek screws included in the manual bag included with the fireplace.



Step 4: Spread some embers along the back side of the burner. Do not place embers with a flat edge down as it may block burner ports.

Keep the embers away from the pilot opening. Do NOT block the ports immediately in front of the pilot.



Step 5: Place Log 04 toward the left side of the firebox, using the two pins for alignment.

Step 6: Place Log 05 on the pin to the right of Log 04. After it's placed, rotate the log until it contacts the pin on the right side of the burner.

Step 7: Spread some embers along the front of the burner. Leave some space where Log 07 will rest. Do not place embers with a flat edge down as it may block burner ports.

Platinum Ember Placement

Step 1: Remove embers from the bag. Be sure to follow handling instructions on the bag. Separate embers by pulling apart. Embers may be flattened or separated into smaller pieces to achieve any desired look.








Figure 26: Figure 27:







Step 1: Place Log 01 on the pin the left, rear corner of the firebox.







Step 3: Install the log bracket in the holes on the left side of the burner using the two (2) black tek screws included in the manual bag.








